COL. AARON D. REID

Col. Aaron D. Reid is the commander of Civil Air Patrol—U.S. Air Force, at Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama. In this position, he provides Air Force advice, assistance, liaison, and oversight to Civil Air Patrol and serves as an adviser to its governing body, the Board of Governors.

Reid previously served as a dean and professor at the School of Advanced Air and Space Studies. Before that, he commanded the 21st Student Squadron at Air Command and Staff College at Maxwell AFB.

He attended the University of Georgia from 2016-2019 on an Air Force Ph.D. fellowship, earning a doctorate in political science and international affairs. He previously earned master's degrees at Air Command and Staff College and Advanced Air and Space Studies.

Reid has served as an F-15E instructor and evaluator pilot at the Air Force Weapons School at Nellis AFB, Nevada. Whileflying the F-15E, he held positions as an assistant director of operations, flight commander, and chief of fighter standardization and evaluations. He earned his pilot wings at Laughlin AFB, Texas, in 2003 and completed his first operational flying tour in the F-15E at Seymour-Johnson AFB, North Carolina.



Reid received his commission in 2002 from Air Force ROTC Detachment 790 at Tennessee State University, Nashville. He is a senior pilot with 1,700 hours in the T-37, T-38, and F-15E. He has flown combat missions in Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom and has also flown multiple Operation Noble Eagle sorties.
