9) What aviation ratings do you have? Examples might include CAP Mission Scanner, Power or Glider Solo, or Private Pilot Certificate (Power or Glider).	





10) Have you traveled internationally after the age of 10? If so, which countries have you been to and what was the purpose of the trip?	
11) Explain the difference between being a tourist and being an ambassador.	
12) Have you participated in any of your wing's past IACE hosting events? If so, how?
