## Packing List

This list has two sections, mandatory and suggested, you may bring what you feel you need, flight suits are not authorized for this activity. Any items you feel you need and did not bring may be purchased at your expense at the AAFES Base Exchange or nearest store (Wal-Mart, Kmart, etc.) Arrangements can be made to provide transportation to and from the store. You must be in uniform, BDU or blues when you arrive at the Flight Academy <u>DO NOT TRAVEL</u> IN YOUR UNIFORM unless in POV, an area will be made available for changing once you reach Midland University or you can do it at the airport.

- Padlock for footlocker
- Phone/calling card (to call parents and family)
- Blue short sleeve uniform (complete) NO BLUE BERETS, NO TIES!
- BDU uniform (complete) BDU style cover preferred
- · Shorts/long pants, khaki color (will be part of your Academy uniform)
- Athletic shoes
- Athletic wear
- Swimsuit
- Undergarments
- Leisure clothes
- Personal hygiene articles
- Towels/wash cloths
- Note paper and pencil/pen
- Sunblock/sunscreen/lip balm
- Prescription medicines (Staff must be notified at check-in)
- Laundry bag (Free laundry facilities in dorms)
- Laundry detergent
