Congratulations, and welcome to Southwest Region National Flight Academy – Powered, or those who selected SWR NFA – Glider. Dates for both NCSAs are 15 June – 25 June 2018. For planning purposes, those flying in commercially will need to arrive at Oklahoma City Will Rogers World Airport (OKC) on 15 June during the morning or early afternoon hours. Your return date is 25 June departing OKC at any convenient time for the cadet. Drivers will need to plan on Shawnee, OK on 15 June, and returning home evening of the 24th or day 25th.

The NFA-P/G is being held at Shawnee, OK. Powered cadets will be flying from Shawnee Regional Airport, and Glider cadets will be flying from Seminole Municipal Airport.

The Activity Director for Powered is Maj Robin Rowden, and the Activity Director for Gliders is Maj Jane Lingenfelter. Their contact information will be sent later in the Operations Order. If you have any early questions feel free to contact me, Lt Col Ed Angala egangala@cap.gov/ 405.503.7940. I am the go-between for both NFAs.

Your clothing list will be contained in the Operations Order that will be sent to you in a week or so. There will be a lot on prerequisites that will need to be completed prior to cadet arrivals. This is especially true for the powered students, such as obtaining FAA Medical Certificates, and Student Pilot Certificates. Read over the Ops Order carefully. If there are prerequisites that a cadet hasn't completed they might not be allowed to solo, or to even start flight training.

There will be a combined Powered and Glider End of Course Banquet on the 24th that if a cadet's family is able to attend they are certainly invited. The food is pretty good, and we will be pinning on the cadet's wings that night. Cadets with family attending can depart after the banquet for home if desired. Guest cost is in the \$10 – \$15 range, but has not been firmed up.

Watch your email address that you have listed in eServices for the Operations Order that will be arriving. If that email address is incorrect, you will be missing out on tasks that need to be started as soon as possible.

And if you find that you are unable to attend for some reason, please contact us as soon as possible.
