- Received the organization's ninth unmodified audit opinion on the FY16 audit
- Throughout the past three years there has been an unprecedented focus on eliminating the financial burden of CAP membership. Various initiatives across all programs include:
 - Reducing the cost of cadet flight activities
 - Providing credit cards in all CAP vehicles to pay for maintenance
 - Providing a subsidy to members who attend National Staff College, NLOC, and NSOC
 - Providing proficiency funds to pilots


