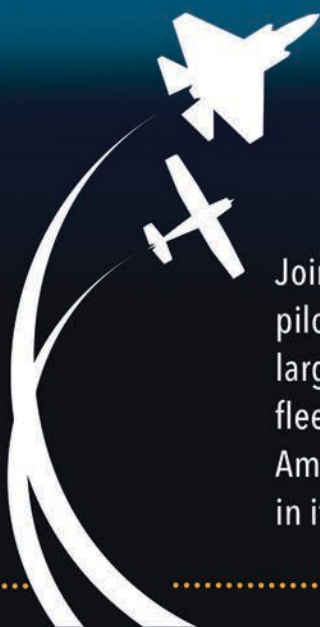

Civil Air Patrol flies primarily Cessna 172s and 182s in service to local communities - homeland security, search and rescue, disaster relief and other operations at local, state or federal agencies' request. Qualified pilots also fly orientation flights for CAP cadets, Air Force ROTC and JROTC cadets, teachers, and to maintain their own flying proficiency.

Our aircraft are located across the nation, readily available to answer the call. All it takes is a valid FAA private or higher certificate, at least a basic medical\* and a current flight review and CAP flight check - and then, along with observers and other aircrew members, you can help when and where help is needed.
