1. Go to eServices and Login.

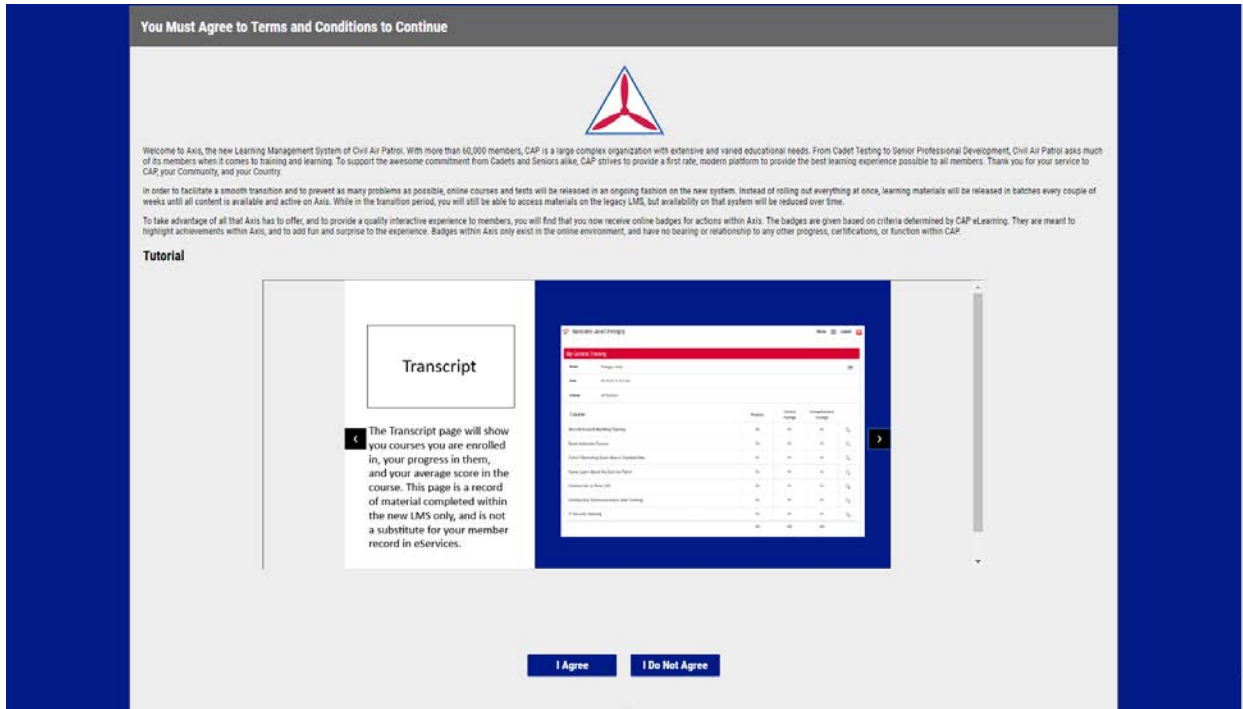
3. At the top of the page, select Go to AXIS. This will take you to the new system.
