CAP Regulation 1-2, dated 7 November 2016 is supplemented as follows. NOTE: this supplement is new in its entirety.

8.3.2.5. **(Added)** The PCR/DA serves as the focal point for all supplements, pamphlets, and OIs and will coordinate with the author or OPR, the region headquarters staff OPRs, the region commander, and with NHQ OPRs for version control and continuity purposes. All supplement, OI, and pamphlet submissions to the region will start with, be routed by, and submitted to PLR and NHQ by the PCR/DA.

8.3.3. **(Added)** All supplements, operating instructions, and pamphlets require region commander review and approval prior to being submitted to NHQ for approval and publication.

8.3.3.3. **(Added)** The proposed draft supplement, OI or pamphlet will be forwarded to the PCR/DA for routing to the appropriate PCR OPR for review and coordination with the submitting unit. Within fourteen days after submission, the PCR OPR will either approve the publication and refer it to the region commander for review and approval, or will advise the PCR/DA to return to the submitter, noting the reason for disapproval and action to secure approval. The region commander will, within fourteen days of submission, either approve and forward through the PCR/DA for submission to NHQ, or return to the submitting unit, noting the disapproval and action to secure approval.
