CIVIL AIR PATROL UNIFORM REGULATION

CAP Regulation 39-1, dated 3 March 2020, is supplemented as follows:

5.1.1.1.2.2. Added. Wear of the Florida Wing patch is mandatory on the ABU uniform for members of Florida Wing. Compliance is mandatory within 90 days of publication of this supplement.

9.4.1.1 Added. The FLWG phase I, II, III & IV Cadet of the Year will be recognized with a maroon box cord, to be worn with class A or B blues. This cord may only be worn within the Florida Wing but may be worn at any wing, group, or squadron function/event where the blues uniform is required. This cord may be worn perpetually by the cadet until they leave CAP or become a senior member as long as the cadet remains in good standing. Should the cadet receive any written disciplinary action or suspension from CAP they may no longer wear the cord.

9.4.1.2 Added. Cadets who complete and graduate from all three Florida Leadership Academies (NCO, SNCO, and CCC) are authorized to wear a black and gold cord (where gold is the center color and black is the edge color) on class A or B blues. Cadets who have earned the FLA cord may also earn a gold aiguillette by returning to FLA as an instructor at any academy. Only one aiguillette may be worn regardless of how many times the cadet returns to instruct. This cord may only be worn within the Florida Wing but may be worn at any wing, group, or squadron function/event where the blues uniform is required. This cord may be worn perpetually by the cadet until they leave CAP or become a senior member.

9.4.1.3 Added. Cadets who earn the Florida Wing Cadet Honor Society member of distinction are authorized to wear a blue and gold cord (where gold in the center color and blue is the edge color) on class A or B blues. Cadets who earn member of high distinction are authorized to wear a gold aiguillette with the cord. This cord may only be worn within the Florida Wing but may be worn at any wing, group, or squadron. This cord may be worn perpetually by the cadet until they leave CAP or become a senior member.

9.4.1.4 Added. The FLWG Cadet of the Year for each squadron will be recognized with a maroon and white box cord, (with the maroon on the outside and white on the inside) to be worn with class A or B blues. This cord may only be worn within the Florida Wing but may be worn at any wing, group, or squadron function/event where the blues uniform is required. This cord may be worn by the cadet for the period of one year following the award, or until they leave CAP or become a senior member as long as the cadet remains in good standing. Should the cadet receive any written disciplinary action or suspension from CAP they may no longer wear the cord.

9.4.1.5 Added. The FLWG Executive Leadership Program will acknowledge a cadet who has graduated the program with distinction per the FLWGP 60-64 by awarding a certificate and a cord. They will be authorized to wear a grey and blue cord (with grey on the outside and blue on the inside) to be worn with class A or B blues. This cord may only be worn within the Florida Wing but may be worn at any wing, group, or

squadron function/event where the blues uniform is required. This cord may be worn perpetually by the cadet until they leave CAP or become a senior member. Should the cadet receive any written disciplinary action or suspension from CAP they may no longer wear the cord.
