CIVIL AIR PATROL UNIFORM REGULATION

CAP Regulation 39-1, dated 03 March 2020 is supplemented as follows:

9.4 Clarified. Uniform items authorized by the New Hampshire Wing Commander will only be worn at meetings and activities hosted by the New Hampshire Wing or its subordinate units.

9.4.1.1 Added. New Hampshire Wing cadets who have graduated or served as staff of the New Hampshire Wing Non-Commissioned Officer Leadership School are authorized to wear a red and white interwoven shoulder cord, worn in accordance with the requirements of CAPR 39-1.

9.4.1.2 Added. Squadrons implementing a local “Cadet of the Month (or Quarter)” program (IAW CAPR 60-1, para 6.2) may award a solid grey interwoven shoulder cord for wear by the cadet being recognized with that designation, worn in accordance with the requirements of CAPR 39-1. The cadet may wear the cord until a new recipient is selected.
