- Color of Money
- Who owns the money?
- How do I get the Money?



- Cadet Kits
 - Become a cadet member and then promote
 - National Headquarters administers
 - Annual Cost— \$285,00
 - Kit 1- \$16.70; Kit 2-\$12.60; Kit 3-\$39.60
 - AF funded
 - Comes automatically upon joining and when achieving Wright & Mitchell milestone



- Curry Blues
 - Receive when earn Curry achievement
 - \$100 for each cadet-discounting 8% w/voucher
 - 45 days to use at Vanguard
 - Redemption rate 2016-60% and 2017-71%
 - National Headquarters administers
 - Annual Cost— \$585,000
 - AF funded
 - Automatic email notification & reminders

CITIZENS SERVING COMMUNITIES



- **Cadet Encampment Assistance Program**
 - Provided for those with self-identified need, approved by commander and allocated funds by National Headquarters
 - National Headquarters administers
 - Annual Cost- \$509k
 - AF funded
 - Apply via eServices & be accepted to an Encampment
 - Payment goes directly to Encampment in most cases

CITIZENS SERVING COMMUNITIES



- Encampment Cost Analysis
 - Median Encampment Cost \$158
 - ACA 1-week sleep-away camp \$690
 - Aim for at least \$225
 - Offer more full & partial scholarships
 - Reimburse costs
 - Feed 'em!



- National Cadet Special Activities
 - Some funds set aside to defray cost of two NCSAs
 - Cadet Officer School and International Air Cadet Exchange
 - National Headquarters administers
 - Annual Cost— \$160,000
 - AF funded
 - Offsets program costs and in case of COS cadets lodging is paid AND reimbursed a stipend for travel

CITIZENS SERVING COMMUNITIES



- Cadet Honor Academy
 - Incentive to create and deliver curriculum
 - National Headquarters administers
 - Annual Cost— \$16,000-\$2K per region
 - Corporate funded
 - Provide Jlee@capnhq.gov with a request for funds along with dates of course



- Region Cadet Leadership School
 - Incentive to create and deliver curriculum
 - National Headquarters administers
 - Annual Cost— \$12,000-\$1.5K per region
 - Corporate funded
 - Provide Jlee@capnhq.gov with a request for funds along with dates of course



- Civil Air Patrol Scholarships
 - Incentive/Reward for progression and support of academic and flying goals
 - Annual Cost— \$110K for next year plus designated scholarships, total portfolio
 - Corporate funded, donors, partner organizations
 - CAP Employee Giving Campaign this year \$10K!
