



## Cadet Supplemental

As an IACE Cadet Ambassador, you would be representing the United States, the U.S. Air Force, and Civil Air Patrol. It's an important role, so to help the selection process, respond to the following prompts. **Be thorough, but use no more than 100 words.**

1) Describe your CAP leadership experience **above** the squadron level. If you have none, describe the leadership experience you do have.

2) Describe your CAP accomplishments and what they mean to you.

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3) Explain the importance of attending activities outside of your unit, such as NCSAs. What can a cadet gain from participating in region or national activities?

4) With regard to your CAP career, think of the last major decision you made. What were the underlying values that helped you make your decision?

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5) Describe your overall experience in the CAP Cadet Program.

6) Describe your community service involvement outside of CAP. Examples might include civic clubs, church groups, or other volunteer groups.

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7) Describe any extracurricular activities that you participate in that have nothing to do with CAP or community service. Examples might include band, sports, theater, etc.

8) What medical certifications do you have? Examples might include CPR or First Aid.

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9) What aviation ratings do you have? Examples might include CAP Mission Scanner, Power or Glider Solo, or Private Pilot Certificate (Power or Glider).

10) Have you traveled internationally after the age of 10? If so, which countries have you been to?

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11) Explain the difference between being a tourist and being an ambassador.

12) Have you participated in any of your wing's past IACE hosting events? If so, how?

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13) What aviation-focused activities does your state have to offer an international visitor?

14) Why do you want to be an IACE Cadet Ambassador?

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15) List the three countries you chose as your preferences. With each country, describe why you want to visit that country.

16) Explain CAP to a local dignitary, such as the mayor of a foreign city.

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17) Explain the purpose of the International Air Cadet Exchange and its parent organization, the International Air Cadet Exchange Association.

18) Explain, in your own words, both the CAP and IACE policies regarding the consumption of alcohol.

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19) If you are in your host country and a tourist not associated with your group makes a rude comment about the United States, what would you do?

20) If you lost or misplaced your passport while in your host country, what steps would you take when you realized it was missing?

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21) Do you have a current passport? If so, what are your passport number and expiration date?

22) If you have a current passport, what country issued it? Examples might include the United States of America. If you do not have a current passport, you should answer, "I do not have a current passport."
