# Wing Supports State, Nation During Unprecedented Times

California Wing members rose to meet one of America's greatest challenges in 2020, providing support for their communities during an unprecedented period of emergency.

Ever ready to respond, over 570 cadets (ages 12 -21) and senior members participated in a total of 389 ground sorties to accomplish three food bank support missions, with more than 2.5 million meals delivered to Californians impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. The wing's continuing commitment to regular training opportunities enabled members to respond quickly when the American Red Cross reached out for support.

In addition to the pandemic, the Golden State again faced a record-setting fire season. At the request of the California Office of Emergency Services, aircraft flew 43 sorties and produced about 150,000 images providing a clearer understanding of the extent of the damage and contributing to critical response strategies.

In 2020 the wing adapted quickly to pandemic-related limitations and used

remote networking technology to conduct multiple successful search and rescue exercises while also continuing to execute U.S. Air Force-assigned missions. Through these exercises and missions, members played integral roles as mission base staff, aircrews and ground and urban direction-finding teams, all while operating under strict protocols to ensure the safety of all involved.
