FACT SHEET

SUBJECT: The National Emergency Services Academy - Mobile Training Team provides an entry level class designed to introduce CAP members and partner agencies to the Domestic Operations Awareness and Assessment Response Tool (DAART): developed and maintained by the US Army Space and Missile Defense Command. This tool is used by many state and federal agencies and provides a Common Operating Picture to improve collaboration between.

DISCUSSION: This 2-day no-cost course is designed to teach participants to use the DAART tool to improve communication both within CAP, between DoD, state and federal agencies. Upon completion students will use the basics of the DAART system as either a DAART Operator or DAART User, depending on the training track selected. Additional ongoing self-study and practice is required to maintain proficiency with this continuously evolving system. DAART Operators are responsible for gathering imagery in the form of still or full motion video as part of an aircrew or ground team. In addition, they can perform in the role of DAART User. DAART Users are responsible for managing and using both the imagery captured by the DAART Operators as well as data and imagery available from other sources. In addition, they perform a communications function between ICP and air/ground team operators. Experience with this system better positions us to be of value to these other agencies who either use this tool currently or wish to adopt it but need guidance and a partner to capture information for them.

OBJECTIVES: The objectives of this course are to train students how to:

- Capture still and full motion imagery with PCs and smartphones using internal and external cameras and video sources.
- Make that imagery available to other CAP members and our partners in near real time
- Share documents, points of interest, flight tracks and other situational awareness resources between users via a Common Operational Picture.
- Integrate data and imagery available from other government and commercial sources.
- Produce reports easily and rapidly using information collected by DAART Operators
- Communicate in near real time directly with other users of the DAART system
- Make informed recommendations/decisions regarding incident tasks/ objectives.

PREREQUISITES: CAP members must be qualified in at least one of the following:

- For DAART Operator (DAARTO): GTM -or- UDF -or- MS. In addition, they must have completed Controlled Cryptographic Item Training (LMS). ICUT
- For DAART User (DAARTU): MRO -or- GTM -or- UDF -or- MSA.
