2. What airport for Arrival and Departure.
Dayton is the primary airport and Columbus is the alternate airport
3. Will we be picked up and returned to the airport?
Yes, and you still be advised a point for pick up.
4. \$2,700.00 does not cover the cost for our team travel. What do we do?
Ask your Squadron, Group, Wing and Region for assistance. Fund Raise.
5. Where are we staying?
Staff and Teams are staying in the Wright State University Dorms. The Registrar will be assigning the rooms. The room charge is included as part of the NCC budget.
6. Where are we taking our meals? At the university dining hall. The meals are included as Part of the NCC budget.
7. Can we bring additional escorts and team members?
No. Any additional personnel are considered guests and are not part of the NCC event. They must provide their own lodging, meals and transportation. No assistance is provided by NCC.
8. What is the cost of the banquet?
There is no cost for the staff and teams. The cost for guests is \$27.00 and they must register thru Eventbrite by Jun 1st. The link to Eventbrite is on the NCC website.
9. Do we need to participate in Elective Event?
Yes, these are events that the Staff has selected from the list of “elective events”. It doesn't mean you can choose to participate or not. They are part of the scoring process. Each year a set of elective events are chosen from the list to be included in the NCC.
10. Do we need to bring anything?
A packing list will be posted on the NCC website of items you might need.
11. How do I get reimbursed?
The reimbursement form is on the NCC website on the right side. Download it, complete it and upload it along with your receipts via the link for submission of documents to NCC Dropbox. The link is advised throughout the NCC Competition Update.

12. How many cadets in Robotics and UAS

The Robotic event has two sections in the competition one allows for 6 cadets to compete and the other is only 2 cadets. Since one portion has the entire team participating please mark on the roster the 2 cadets for the other portion.

For UAS, it has 2 events, 4 cadets will participate in the Written Exam and 2 cadets will participate in the Flying portion. This allows for all 6 cadets to participate.
