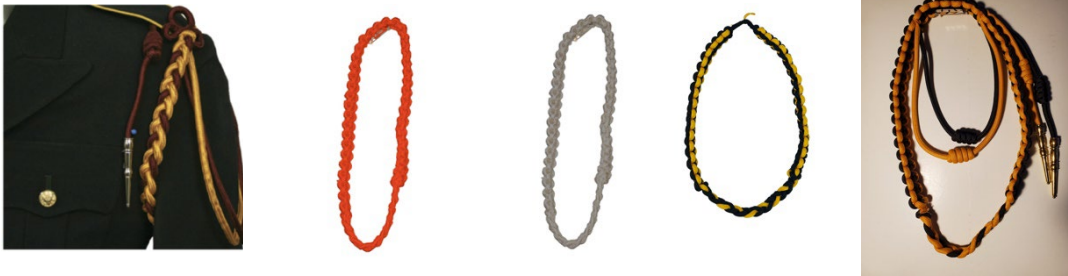
CAP Regulation 39-1, dated 3 Mar 2020, is supplemented as follows:

6.2.8.1 added. GAWG CAP Baseball Caps. Units (chartered groups, squadrons and flights) may choose to adopt a unit baseball cap. All unit baseball caps must be approved by the Wing Commander in writing. Unit baseball caps will be dark blue and have the unit emblem embroidered on the front, at a 2 ½ inch height. Wing Headquarter staff will wear a black baseball cap, with the Wing emblem embroidered on the front, at a 2 ½ inch height. Members of the Incident Management Team (IMT) can wear a dark blue or orange baseball cap with the IMT emblem embroidered on the front, at a 2 ½ inch height. Once approved by the Wing Commander the unit may purchase and wear the authorized unit baseball cap. Purchase and maintenance of the supply of unit baseball caps is a unit responsibility and expense. Unit baseball caps may be worn with uniform combinations as prescribed in CAPR 39-1. All authorized baseball caps shall not be worn outside of Georgia Wing.

9.4.1.1 added. Cadets are authorized to wear the following cords on the USAF Blue Dress uniforms (Class A or B) as prescribed in CAPR 39-1 para 9.4.1. These cords shall not be worn outside of Georgia Wing.

- Cadets who are active members of the Georgia Wing Cadet Honor Society are authorized to wear a Double Strand Shoulder Cord with Nickel Tip, of maroon and dark gold
- Cadet of the Quarter/Month – Orange single color top cord
- Squadron Cadet of the Year – Grey single color top cord
- Cadets of the Year – (Phase I, II, III, and IV Cadet of year) Black & Gold two color top cord. The overall Cadet of the Year Black & Gold two color top cord with knot
