CIVIL AIR PATROL UNIFORM MANUAL

CAP Manual 39-1, dated 26 June 2014, is supplemented as follows:

6.2.9 Delaware Wing members may wear a baseball cap with all applicable utility uniforms except the ABU. Unit commanders may authorize the wear of unit baseball caps for wear with the ABU, but they will not be worn outside of unit activities. The baseball cap will be navy blue, polyester and mesh, adjustable, one size fits all, and have a medium crown and a large visor. Lettering is one inch in height, embroidered, gold in color, centered two inches above the visor with block, all caps type font. The lettering will read DE-XXX (XXX to be the charter number of the unit the member is assigned to, e.g., DE-001, DE-004, DE-022).

10.7.8.1 Added. Each squadron desiring to create a patch for their organization must submit to the wing commander a request in writing with a color drawing defining every point, color, use, symbol, and purpose of the patch. A squadron patch must be at least two and one half inches in height/width but no larger than three inches in height and width. No patches shall be ordered or manufactured prior to written approval. Units with existing organizational emblems are encouraged to modify the design when new patches are ordered to meet the intent of the USAF heraldic guidelines published by the Air Force Historical Research Agency.:

CAP Transition to Airman Battle Dress Uniform (ABU) Left Sleeve. The wing commander does not mandate wear of a wing patch.
