TRANSPORTATION

OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CAP VEHICLES

CAPR 77-1, dated 26 December 2012, is supplemented as follows:

1.1.1. Added. E-ZPass transponders: The State of Delaware has issued Delaware Wing E-ZPass transponders to be used for official CAP business in Corporate-owned vehicles. The use of an E-Z pass in Delaware will be at no cost for official business/vehicles (unless utilizing an "express lane", which are deemed a convenience). Any tolls outside of Maryland charged to the Wing account will have those charges passed back to the squadron utilizing the vehicle. The State of Delaware will revoke the E-ZPass privileges due to misuse, abuse, and speed violations. Individual members are responsible for any violations resulting from the use/misuse of the transponder.

1.2.1. Added. The Delaware Wing Director of Logistics will assign specific E-ZPass transponders, identified by serial number, to specific CAP corporate vehicles. The transponders shall not be removed from the CAP vehicle to which it is assigned without the approval of the Director of Logistics. Replacement of defective/malfunctioning unit must also be coordinated through the Director of Logistics.

1.2.2. Added. Unit commanders will be responsible for transponders assigned to corporate vehicles in their unit. Individual members with an assigned corporate vehicle will be responsible for any transponder assigned to that vehicle. Unit commanders and individual members with transponders will sign the acceptance agreement in Attachment 1 acknowledging receipt of the transponder and a short briefing on its use. A copy of the signed acceptance agreement will be kept in the vehicle assigned the transponder.
