# Health Metrics for Remobilization

## North Carolina

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COVID RISK LEVEL

### Active outbreak

North Carolina is either actively experiencing an outbreak or is at extreme risk. COVID cases are exponentially growing and/or North Carolina's COVID preparedness is significantly below international standards.



ALERT

Add your phone to [North Carolina's exposure notification system](#) to receive alerts if you were in close contact with someone who later tests positive for COVID. Your privacy is protected as your identity is not known and your location is not tracked.

### DAILY NEW CASES

# Health and Safety Requirements for Meetings and Activities

- **The NCWCG will reposition to CAP Phase I effective 29 January.**
- Phase I allows for no more than 10 total personnel to be in attendance for any event or meeting, indoors or outdoors.
- **The only change from the current phase is that outdoor gatherings are now limited to 10 personnel.**





# Health and Safety Requirements for Meetings and Activities

- No more than 10 total personnel are allowed to be in attendance for **any** event or meeting.
- Masks or face coverings **will be worn at all times** and by all personnel. If using gloves follow the CDC guidelines for proper use and disposal.
- Cadets **must** have the NCWGW pre-filled quarterly CAPF 60-80 and CAPF 60-81 on file to participate in any in person activity or meeting .
- Meeting / activity rosters will be emailed to Lt Col Shelley Gonzales within 24 hours of the meeting. This is to facilitate contact tracing if necessary.
- Squadron Commanders will provide CLEAR guidance that members with any COVID-19 symptoms (loss of taste or smell, sneezing, coughing, congestion) NOT attend the meeting **and for members to self-report if they develop symptoms or test positive after attending.**
