Aircraft Maintenance

CIVIL AIR PATROL AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT

CAPR 66-1, 14 September 2015 (with ICL 17-06 28 July 2017), is supplemented as follows:

This supplement establishes standard aircraft maintenance management procedures for all Civil Air Patrol corporate owned aircraft assigned to the ND Wing. Information contained herein is applicable to all personnel who operate and/or maintain CAP corporate aircraft.

4.5 (added): Maintenance of Wing Aircraft

4.2.1 Aircraft maintenance will normally be accomplished at the Wing Consolidated Maintenance Facility (CMF) in Bismarck/Mandan. Prior approval of the Wing Logistics Officer or Wing Aircraft Maintenance Officer, or their designated representative, is required. Aircraft will be scheduled for maintenance at the CMF by the ND/LGM (or designee) and will be flown to the CMF in Bismarck/Mandan using the monthly "A" mission number and a mission symbol of A9. Prior coordination with ND/DO (or designee) is required.

11.1 (added) Records

11.1.1 Units assigned an aircraft shall keep current the Aircraft Maintenance Information section of WMIRS in the Maintenance Module. Unit maintenance officers shall also provide current inputs to the "Aircraft Resource Matrix" page of the module when maintenance is performed on the aircraft.
