Award of CAP Medals, Ribbons, and Certificates

CAP Regulation 39-3, dated 28 December 2012, is supplemented as follows:

Paragraph 10d. Presentation at Wing Conference. Added. Recommendations for decorations may be submitted at any time throughout the year. For presentation at the wing conference, decoration packages must be submitted by 15 January.

Paragraph 18b. To ensure timely processing of awards, commanders below the wing level are authorized to approve the awards listed below. Award and service ribbon requests for commanders will be submitted to the next echelon of command for approval. Ribbons not prescribed below will follow the normal award approval process.

(1) Air Search and Rescue Ribbon.

(2) Cadet Advisory Council. Bronze star is awarded by Group Commander, silver star is awarded by Wing Commander, and gold star is awarded by Region Commander.

(3) Community Service Ribbon.

(4) Cadet Orientation Pilot Ribbon.

(5) Command Service Ribbon. Squadron level ribbon is approved by Group Commander, and group level ribbon is approved by Wing Commander.

(6) Counterdrug Ribbon.

(7) Disaster Relief Ribbon. Basic ribbon only.

(8) Encampment Ribbon.

(9) Homeland Security Ribbon.

(10) International Air Cadet Exchange Ribbon.

(11) National Cadet Special Activity Ribbon.

(12) Recruiter Ribbon. Both cadet and senior ribbon award.

(13) Red Service Ribbon.

Paragraph 19. Following approval at the group level, awards requiring INWG/CC approval will be submitted to awards@inwg.cap.gov with a courtesy copy to wa@inwg.cap.gov. The use of electronic signatures is acceptable for all awards submissions unless otherwise specified.

Section G. Award nominations will be submitted via the eServices Awards Module for all awards that allow processing through this system. For awards not eligible for eServices submission, follow the nomination procedures established in the award's controlling publication.

57. Indiana Wing Awards. Added. To recognize exceptional performance amongst members and units not otherwise covered by the national level awards program, Indiana Wing has established wing level awards.

a. Wing Awards Information. Added. INWGP 30-1, *Indiana Wing Awards Program*, details each award that the wing will award annually. This document provides eligibility criteria, a description of the award, and any associated background information.

b. Nominations/Submissions. Added. Nominations and submissions for the wing level awards are accomplished by submitting a CAPF 120, *Recommendation for Decoration* (or other form/document as specified in INWGP 30-1) to awards@inwg.cap.gov. Submissions must be received by 15 January annually.
