Aircraft Maintenance

CIVIL AIR PATROL AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT

CAP Regulation 130-2, dated 04 October 2021 is supplemented as follows:

2.3.1. Added. Aircraft Maintenance Officers. The AZWG/LGM, duty position of "Maintenance Officer" as assigned in e-services is designated as "Aircraft Maintenance Officers" (AMO) for the purposes of this supplement and CAPR 130-2.

2.5. Added. Designated CAP Aircraft Maintenance Providers. SkyQuest Aviation LLC, Glendale AZ and Velocity Air, Inc., Tucson AZ are the designated repair and maintenance facility for aircraft and should be used for all annual, 100-hour inspections and major maintenance. When it is not possible to use designated facility, the AMO shall arrange approval for an acceptable alternative maintenance provider (IAW with CAPR 130-2).

5.11 Added. Monthly Flight Log Reporting. Each Squadron Commander, or their designee, will reconcile the previous month's "Aircraft Flight Time Log" sheet, from the AIF to the Aircraft Log in WMIRS for the same time-period. Once these two logs are reconciled, a Monthly Flight Time Report via email shall be sent to the AZWG/DO, or their designee, certifying the agreement between these two logs. This report is by calendar month and is due by the 5th of each month.

14.5.1. Added. Survival Kit. Survival/First Aid Kit contents are specified on the inventory sheet in each survival kit's front pocket.
