Aircraft Maintenance

CIVIL AIR PATROL AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT

CAP Regulation 130-2, dated 4 October 2021, which includes (ICL 22-01 3 March 2022), is supplemented as follows:

2.2.1 (Added). Wings. The Wing Commander has designated the Aircraft Maintenance Officer (AMO) to administer all phases of CAPR 130-2 and this supplement to operate an Aircraft Maintenance Program. The Wing AMO shall report to the Wing Director of Operations regarding proper maintenance record keeping and logistical management of corporate owned aircraft. The Wing AMO shall advise the Wing Director of Operations regarding aircraft status and required aircraft movements in accordance with CAPR 130-2.

7.5.1 (Added). Aircraft Maintenance Repair and Documentation (AMRAD) Entries. The pilot will contact the Wing Aircraft Maintenance Officer or the Assistant AMO to report the discrepancy immediately but not later than eight hours. If the pilot cannot contact the AMO or the Assistant AMO, the pilot will then make the entry to the AMRAD Aircraft Maintenance Data Page.

9.1 (Added). Aircraft Maintenance Approval Authority. The Wing AMO and assistants will be responsible for making maintenance arrangements with the maintenance provider. They will be the sole point of contact and the only personnel authorized to speak for the Wing with respect to aircraft maintenance requirements. If unusual, urgent or emergency repairs are required when away from home field, the Pilot in Command will inform the Flight Release Officer (FRO) and obtain maintenance instructions from the PRWG AMO, or the Wing Assistant AMO, depending upon who may be reached first.

10.5 (Added). The pilot will complete F-71 and ensure all maintenance items have been appropriately cleared and annotated in aircraft logs. Pilot will forward the F-71 to the Wing AMO for updating AMRAD.

10.6 (Added). Wing AMO is responsible for updating Aircraft Maintenance Information in AMRAD.

14.5.1 (Added). Survival Kits. Survival kits will be inspected annually, and date of the inspection will be noted on the monthly CAPF 71.
