CIVIL AIR PATROL AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT

CAP Regulation 130-2, dated 06 October 2023, is supplemented as follows:

{10. Scheduled Maintenance} Upon delivery of an aircraft to a maintenance facility, a list of the work requested and/or any discrepancies to be addressed will be provided. It is the maintenance facility's responsibility to take whatever actions are required to ensure that the aircraft is completely inspected, serviced, and/or repaired.
