FINANCIAL PROCEDURES AND ACCOUNTING

CAP Regulation 173-1, dated 15 November 2012 (including ICL 17-02), is supplemented as follows:

8. Unit Finance Officer. Added. All Florida Wing squadrons which are created or designated as school squadrons (800 series) do not require a finance officer to be assigned.

9. c. Finance Committee. Units Below Wing Level. Added. Pursuant to the waiver authority granted to the Wing Commander in this paragraph, all Florida Wing squadrons which are created or designated and operating as school squadrons and, as such, do not solicit, and or collect or maintain funds are hereby declared as waived from the requirement to appoint or maintain a finance committee and such requirement is waived as to each of said school squadrons. The waivers granted hereby shall continue in full force and effect unless and until revoked or withdrawn so long as the units included in this waiver remain classified as school squadrons and operate as such regardless of changes of command of said squadrons.

In the event that any fundraising activity is undertaken to benefit a squadron which is waived under this wing supplement, the squadron is prohibited from participating in the fundraising event or supporting it as a squadron event. Members are prohibited from participating in uniform or purporting to act on behalf of the squadron. In the event funds are raised or donated by or through third parties, said funds are prohibited from being placed under the control of the unit leadership and must be handled by and managed by the sponsoring educational institution.
