



CIVIL AIR PATROL UNIFORM REGULATION

CAPR 39-1, dated 3 March 20, (Including ICL 21-01, 9 Aug 2021) is supplemented as follows:

4.2.5.1.8. Unit baseball caps IAW para 6.2.8 below are authorized for wear at wing and subordinate unit meetings and activities.

4.2.6.8. Unit baseball caps IAW para 6.2.8 below are authorized for wear at wing and subordinate unit meetings and activities.

5.1.1.9.2. Unit baseball caps IAW para 6.2.8 below are authorized for wear at wing and subordinate unit meetings and activities.

5.2.1.2.3. Unit baseball caps IAW para 6.2.8 below are authorized for wear at wing and subordinate unit meetings and activities.

5.3.7. Unit baseball caps IAW para 6.2.8 below are authorized for wear at wing and subordinate unit meetings and activities.

6.2.8.1 Added. CAP baseball caps as defined in this paragraph are authorized for wear in the Nebraska Wing with the aviator uniform, ABU, corporate style working uniforms, or flight duty uniforms. The hat must be a standard single-color baseball hat that is worn with the brim of the cap facing forward.

The hat will be a conservative color and not be a prohibited color as per CAP regulations. Units will submit their proposed hat color and design to NEWG/CC directly for approval via CAP Memorandum Format. Previously authorized hats do not need to be reauthorized. Letters will be 3" - 5" in height. Squadron patches are not authorized on hats. Examples include: "OFFCS" for Offutt Composite, "OCS" for Omaha Composite and "NEWG" for Nebraska Wing Headquarters. These have previously been authorized and do not need to be resubmitted.

8.2.8.3. Unit baseball caps IAW para 6.2.8 above are authorized for wear at wing and subordinate unit meetings and activities.

8.3.8. Unit baseball caps IAW para 6.2.8 above are authorized for wear at wing and subordinate unit meetings and activities.

9.4.1.1. Added. Only the following shoulder cords may be worn by cadets at Nebraska Wing activities when the blues uniform is worn. They may not be worn at activities outside of the Nebraska Wing unless authorized by CAP regulations (i.e. while participating in CAC or color guard/honor guard events). See CAPR 39-1 para 9.3, for wear information. Shoulder Cord colors approved:

White: Worn by color guard team members

Red/White: NEWG Cadet of the Year – worn until cadet turns senior member

Gold/Blue: Academic Excellence

Blue/White: Unit Level Award approved annually by NEWG HQ Cadet Advisory

Council: See CAPR 39-1 para 9.3.1.

9.4.1.2. Added. Academic Excellence: This cord is for cadets who have demonstrated academic excellence. Cadets need to provide proof they earned a minimum of a 3.5 on a 4.0 scale for each semester to their unit commander who will approve the request on a CAP Form 2A. Cadets will only wear their cord for the semester following the one in which they earned the award.

9.4.1.3. Added. Unit Level Awards. This cord will be awarded from an approved unit program that has been submitted annually to the Nebraska Wing Headquarters for approval. The program must have established rules on how the unit will decide who gets the award. The award may be designated for any timeframe the unit chooses. No more than two cadets, at a time, per unit, may wear this unit level cord.

9.4.1.4. Added. All cords are the individual's or unit's responsibility to purchase except for the wing cadet of the year cord.
