



CAPR 39-1 ICL 21-01, dated 3 March 2020, is supplemented as follows:

5.1.1.1.2.2 Clarified. The wear of the Delaware Wing patch on the left sleeve of the ABU coat is optional.

5.1.2.4 Amended. Unit logos on t-shirts are authorized but must meet the current design and heraldry standards of Civil Air Patrol and approved by the Delaware Wing Historian. Designs must be submitted to the Wing Commander for approval.

5.1.1.2.2 Added. Activity t-shirts from any CAP activity are authorized for wear in uniform outside of the activity as long as they meet the color and construction requirement for the specific uniform.

6.2.98 Amended. Delaware Wing members may wear a baseball cap with all applicable utility uniforms except the ABU. Unit commanders may authorize the wear of unit baseball caps for wear with the ABU, but they will not be worn outside of the unit. The baseball cap will be navy blue, adjustable, have a medium crown and a large visor. Lettering is one inch in height, embroidered, gold in color, centered two inches above the visor with block, all caps type font. The lettering will read DE-XXX (XXX to be the charter number of the unit the member is assigned).

6.2.99 Added The Unit baseball cap will not be worn with ABU's during Wing, Regional or National activities unless otherwise specified by the activity director.

9.3.5 Added Cadets recognized as the Delaware Wing Cadet of the Year, Junior Cadet Officer of the Year, or Non-Commissioned Officer of the Year are authorized to wear a royal blue and gold woven shoulder cord on their left shoulder recognizing these special honor positions.

9.4.1 Added. Cadets of the month and quarter in DEWG squadrons are permitted to wear a shoulder cord on their left shoulder during the period when they are recognized with that designation. The color of these cords are at the discretion of the squadron commander but shall not be the same as designated in para 9.3. These shoulder cords will be worn in a manner described in to 9.4.1

9.4.1.3.1 Added. A CAPF2A will be completed each quarter/month for the award. The unit commander is the approving authority. A copy of the approved CAPF2A will be filed in the cadet's personnel file.

10.9.7 Added. Each squadron desiring to create a patch for their organization must submit to the wing commander a request in writing with a color drawing defining every point, color, use, symbol, and purpose of the patch. All new patch submissions and request for modification of existing organizational patches are ordered to meet the intent of the USAF heraldic guidelines published by the Air Force Historical Research Agency.
