AWARD OF CAP MEDALS, RIBBONS AND CERTIFICATES

CAP Regulation 39-3, dated 28 March 2012, including ICL 18-02, dated 2 March 2018, and ICL 19-02, dated 22 February 2019, and ICL 21-03, dated 1 December 2021, is supplemented as follows:

10.c.(7) Added. Wing scholarships may be available for cadets to attend Special Activities. The DEWG/DCP will announce the types of scholarships available, the process for applying for them, and the time frame for submitting. The Awards Committee or Wing National Special Activity Review Board will rank the applicants and submit a recommendation list to the Wing Commander. The finance committee will be convened for payment approvals. Standard conditions that apply are:

- a. The applicant must have already been accepted into the activity prior to applying.
- b. Scholarships will be sent to the member as a reimbursement after successful completion of the activity. Members will submit a copy of receipts to the Director of Finance on a DEWG Form 5.

18. b. (1). Added The Delaware Wing Commander delegates authority to award the following Activity and Service Ribbons and their associated clasps/devices to Squadron Commanders for their staff and members of their units:

International Air Cadet Exchange Ribbon - once posted in CAP eServices

National Cadet Competition Ribbon

National Color Guard Competition Ribbon

Cadet Specialty Activity Ribbon - once posted in CAP eServices

Encampment Ribbon - once posted in CAP eServices

Red Service Ribbon

Community Service Ribbon

Cadet Advisory Council Ribbon

Recruiter Ribbon

Command Service Ribbon (to subordinate commanders only)

Counterdrug Ribbon

Disaster Relief Ribbon

Cadet Orientation Pilot Ribbon

Homeland Security Ribbon

18. b. (2). Added The following ribbon requests will be sent to the DEWG/DO for verification prior to being approved by the Delaware Wing Commander:

Added. SECTION I – DELAWARE WING AWARDS

57.a. Added. Squadron Commander of the Year. This optional annual award recognizes the squadron commander who demonstrates exemplary leadership in helping his/her squadron to be highly successful. The award winner is one who exemplifies CAP's core values and servant leadership. The selection for this award will be made by the Command Team.

57. b. Added. Lt Col John McGaha Memorial Torch Award. An annual award determined by the Wing cadet of the year to recognize a senior member who has been most impactful or influential in their CAP service. The cadet of the year shall notify the DEWG/DCP of their selection for the Torch Award along with a narrative as to why they selected the recipient.
