CADET PROGRAM MANAGEMENT

CAP Regulation 60-1, dated 26 Oct 21, is supplemented as follows:

4.3.3.1. Added. All unit-level cadet activities will be coordinated and published via the West Virginia Wing web-based calendar. The Wing web-based calendar of cadet activities will be available to all members as well as parents of cadets. It will be the responsibility of the units to submit unit-level activity requests for all activities using the online activity request form so they will be reflected on the wing web-based calendar, once approved by the WVWG/CV (or designee).

8.2.1. In addition to Cadet Invest National CAP Academic and Flight Scholarships, cadet members of West Virginia Wing are eligible to apply for several additional scholarships, some of which are only available to WV Wing cadets. They include: (1) WV Wing Flight Scholarship (Powered and Glider); (2) WV Wing Special Activities Scholarship; (3) Omar W. Crim/WVU Academic Scholarship; (4) WVU Leadership Scholarship; (5) the Colonel Rodney F. Moody Memorial CAP Scholarship; (6) the West Virginia Wing Civil Air Patrol Cadet Scholarship and (7) West Virginia Wing Health Services Scholarship.
