SOUTWEST REGION CHAPLAIN CORPS STAFF COLLEGE 2022

The Southwest Region Chaplain Corps Staff College 2022 was cancelled due to inability to get the minimum number of students. Those wishing to attend were referred to online colleges.

EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES:

The Southwest Region Chaplain Corps was still recovering from Covid. Cadet activities were experiencing outbreaks of covid, the omicron variation. Encampment numbers were high due to Cadet Programs helping cadets to continue their CAP careers. The following chaplains served as Encampment Chaplain during 2022: Ch Tom Bauder and Ch Thomas Tureman – AZ WG Encampment; Ch Blanchard Jacobus and Ch Nancy Smalley – TX WG Encampment; Ch John Rollyson – OK WG Encampment; Ch John Tober – NM WG Encampment; Ch Larry Killian – AR WG Encampment; Ch Larry Beane – LA WG Encampment.

The number of approved applications for Character Development Instructor was nineteen, with the approved applications for chaplain was eleven. Less than a handful of chaplains and CDIs have attended the online or in person ChESS training from the Southwest Region.

CONCERNS FOR THE FUTURE

Mission Chaplains – Thirty percent of Southwest Region 67 chaplains are qualified as mission chaplains. However, only Eleven percent of its 139 CDIs are qualified as Chaplain Support Specialists. During the last year only 1 new chaplain became qualified and two

CDIs. More training needs to take place in SWR and go through the normal emergency services training process. Even with online training few members can attend the month long training and the real world experience is lacking. Waiting for ChESS or the traveling training is not workable and should be changed.
