### A PROVEN PROGRAM

Civil Air Patrol offers schools a ready-to-use program that's been successful with students from ages 12 to 20 throughout the United States. By starting a CAP unit for students at your school, students can be introduced to standardized lesson plans that cover:

- Aerospace concepts to enrich the Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) curricula
- Leadership and character principles
- Healthy and drug-free lifestyle guidance
- Career opportunity exploration

### TAILORED TO THE SCHOOL YEAR

CAP has taken its successful cadet program and modified it to fit the typical school calendar. This program can be delivered over a six-year period, with

36 sessions per school year (18 per semester). Each session lasts for two hours. The program can be conducted either during or after school. Students who take part in this school program complete the same 16-step progression currently followed by other CAP cadets. They wear cadet (Air Force-style) uniforms and adhere to all



CAP regulations for behavior and advancement. As they work their way up through the cadet program, they advance in rank from Cadet Airman Basic to Cadet Colonel.

### AWARDS

There's more to CAP's program than just ranks and uniforms. As cadets excel at different levels in the program, they can earn prestigious awards, including the coveted Spaatz Award. They can take advantage of more than \$300,000 in scholarships for colleges and training schools across the nation. They can participate in powered and glider airplane flights. They can attend cadet encampments for specialized training in fields such as search and rescue, aviation, engineering, meteorology and public service.



### POSITIVE FUTURES

CAP gives students a chance to belong to something positive. And they have fun! For many, CAP is the first step toward a military career. Others develop a fascination with aviation and go on to become pilots or technical workers in the aerospace industry.
