...our membership

- Amount spent on grants since last conference: \$15,500 (affecting more than 300 cadets at National, Region, Wing, Unit and Individual level) through June. Anticipate approximately \$10,000 more through the end of the year.
- Flight scholarships: 4 at \$3500 (\$163,000 awarded to date)
- Academic scholarships: 1 at \$2,500 (First awardee this year)!

earned the Mitchell Award completed a solo in a powered aircraft, and maintained a 3.0 GPA in high school.

In 2013, The Spaatz Association Leadership Grant Program was launched to recognize and encourage the development of leadership excellence through financial support.

Grants are available for individuals, units, and national-level special programs.



Remember when National Headquarters sent out wallet-sized replicas of the Spaatz Award certificate to all new recipients?

One of the giants in the history of airpower, Carl "Tooey" Spaatz, with another pilot in 1929, set a flight endurance record of one-hundred and fifty hours.

Shown here is the aerial refueling of his aircraft, The Question Mark (bottom).

During WWII, General Spaatz directed the air campaign against the Nazis. In the Pacific Theatre, the atomic bombing took place under his command.

After serving as the U.S. Air Force's first chief of staff, General Spaatz became the first chairman of the Civil Air Parto National Board, where he looked with immense pride upon CAP cadets, recognizing them as "dynamic Americans and aerospace leaders."



The Spaatz Association has secured the rights from Civil Air Patrol to be the sole distributor of replacement cards and cards for Award winners with numbers earlier than #2000.
