A Career in Army Aviation as an A&P Technician

Introduction

The United States Army Aviation Logistics School (USAALS) was established at Fort Eustis, Virginia, on 1 October 1983, and is devoted to the support of Army aviation logistics operations through the development of training for enlisted and warrant officer personnel.



The Army Aviation **Airframe and Powerplant (A&P) Certification Training Program** offers maintenance courses to Soldiers in the Aviation Maintenance field. Soldiers enrolled in the program will be able to obtain credit for their military experience in coordination with a broad spectrum of intensive instructional courses which will prepare them for the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) written, oral and practical examinations. The courses within the program follow the same curriculum as our civilian counterpart schools giving graduates of the program a distinctive edge in the military and civilian Aviation community.

The A&P Program Administrator will send an enrollment package inclusive of digital courseware and a Qualification Training Packet (QTP) to applicants who meet all eligibility criteria. Below are the course and MOS (15 series) for Aviation Maintenance.
