



Walmart Community Grant Guidelines and FAQ

Range of Grants: \$250-\$5,000 – squadrons/units can submit up to 25 applications and/or receive up to 25 grants within a grant cycle.

Grant Cycle: Application deadline is Dec 31. The grants cycle begins February 1.



4) Please complete the form that appears. Once the form is completed, an email will be sent to **Civil Air Patrol-Development**, requesting access to your organization in FrontDoor. Your email will be sent immediately, and you should soon receive a response, directly from **Civil Air Patrol-Development** related to your request for access.

You will receive an email from CyberGrants/FrontDoor that your access has been approved. You will access the link within the email to change your password. After changing your password please log into your account.

Upon approval of your FrontDoor registration, please visit http://www.cybergrants.com/walmart/commgrant_501 and login with your FrontDoor credentials, to submit your grant application.

What's next?

Simultaneously contact the local Walmart facility manager where you will direct the grant application request *and* complete the online application. If that person is interested in supporting the CAP use of the grant, then you are 80% of the way there!

Once your application is formally submitted, the information for the proposed grant request will go to the facility manager. That's why it is important to talk to them first and get them on board with your proposal first. If the facility manager tells you that he/she won't support the request, then you need to move on to a different store in the area.
