Judith Fedder (Lieutenant General, USAF Retired)

U.S. Air Force Lt Gen (Ret) Judith Fedder is an independent consultant and currently serves as Chair of the Civil Air Patrol (CAP) Board of Governors.

As CAP's top governing body, the 11-member Board of Governors (BoG) consists of four Air Force appointees, three members appointed jointly by the Secretary of the Air Force and CAP's national commander, and four members-at-large selected by CAP's Senior Advisory Group. The BoG moves CAP forward through collective decision-making to generate strategic policies, plans, and programs designed to guide it both today and tomorrow. It is assisted by CAP's National Commander and Chief Executive Officer, the organization's Chief Operating Officer and the CAP-U.S. Air Force Commander, who act as advisers.



Gen Fedder joined the BoG in June 2015, shortly after retiring as Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics, Installations and Mission Support with Headquarters U.S. Air Force at the Pentagon in Washington, D.C., where she attained the rank of Lieutenant General.

Throughout her 35-year Air Force career, Gen Fedder was assigned to numerous aircraft maintenance organizations and commanded units from squadron to wing levels at Air Force bases in Florida, Italy, Portugal, and Oklahoma. At the Pentagon she served as Director of Legislative Liaison in the Office of the Secretary of the Air Force, as the Executive Officer to the Chief of Staff of the Air Force, and as the Air Force Director of Logistics. After her Air Force career, she served as Director of Global Sales and Marketing for the Boeing Company until June 2017.

Gen Fedder is a member of the Department of Defense's Defense Advisory Committee on Women in the Services and serves on the United States Air Force Academy Board of Visitors.

Major awards and decorations for Gen Fedder include the Air Force's Distinguished Service Medal with oak leaf cluster, Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit with oak leaf cluster, Meritorious Service Medal with four oak leaf clusters, Joint Service Commendation Medal with oak leaf cluster, Air Force Commendation Medal, and the Air Force Achievement Medal.

Gen Fedder holds a Master of Business Administration (MBA) from the Florida Institute of Technology in Melbourne, and a Bachelor's degree from Michigan State University in East Lansing, where she was a distinguished graduate of the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) program. In 2014, she was presented with Michigan State University's Distinguished Alumni Award.
